Further details:

Name of Enrolling Area: You may put the name of your Enrolling Area only, or the name of your Enrolling Area and your Department/Centre/Institute.
If you put both, the Enrolling Area name will go first and the Department/Centre/Institute name underneath.

Thesis Title: This must be the title that has been agreed by yourself and your Supervisor and duly approved by the FGSC. It must read as it appears on the Student database.

Author: This must be the candidate's full name only – do not include any previous qualifications after the name.

Date: The month and year shown must be the month and year in which your thesis is originally submitted for examination.

Once all lines are typed, space them evenly down the page. The space from the top of the page down to the Top line (name of Enrolling Area) should be equal to the space from the bottom of the page up to the last line (month and year).

Before you can submit your thesis for examination, the Title Page of your thesis must be approved by the Thesis Examinations Officer (TEO).

You may email the Title Page to: thesis@curtin.edu.au or bring it in to the Graduate Research School. The TEO will notify you if any amendments are necessary and advise you of the other submission requirements. The approved page will be returned to you and cc'd to the Guild Copy & Design Centre to be used as reference for your permanent binding.
