Your portfolio must include:	
<p>A portfolio submission checklist (this document) – Please include a checklist for each portfolio application you submit.</p>	
<p>An Introductory letter – This should be an explanation of why you want to attend Curtin University, the reasons and motivation behind the course you have chosen, and your future career goals. The letter should reflect your commitment, preparation to study and motivation to be successful.</p>	
<p>A Resume – The resume should outline education and work experience to date. It should include details of paid work and any voluntary positions held.</p>	
<p>Letter(s) of support – The letter should be from a school or other work or professional representative who can provide details of your academic performance, aptitude and likelihood to succeed in the chosen university course.</p>	
<p>Academic records – Could include: secondary schooling, TAFE/Registered Training Organisation (RTO) qualifications, industry training/accreditation, workplace training. Current school leavers are required to provide their most recent school reports, including their predicted ATAR (if applicable), ATAR course report and Western Australian Statement of Student Achievement (WASSA) when they become available.</p>	
<p>Other records – If you have undertaken extracurricular activities relevant to your chosen area of study, you are encouraged to provide related documents. For example: leadership programs, examples of artwork, entered competitions, sports coaching etc.</p>	
<p>Check your scans – Ensure your portfolio documents meet Curtin’s Scanned documents and certification requirements and guidelines. Please note, your scanned documents do <u>not</u> need to be certified.</p>
